

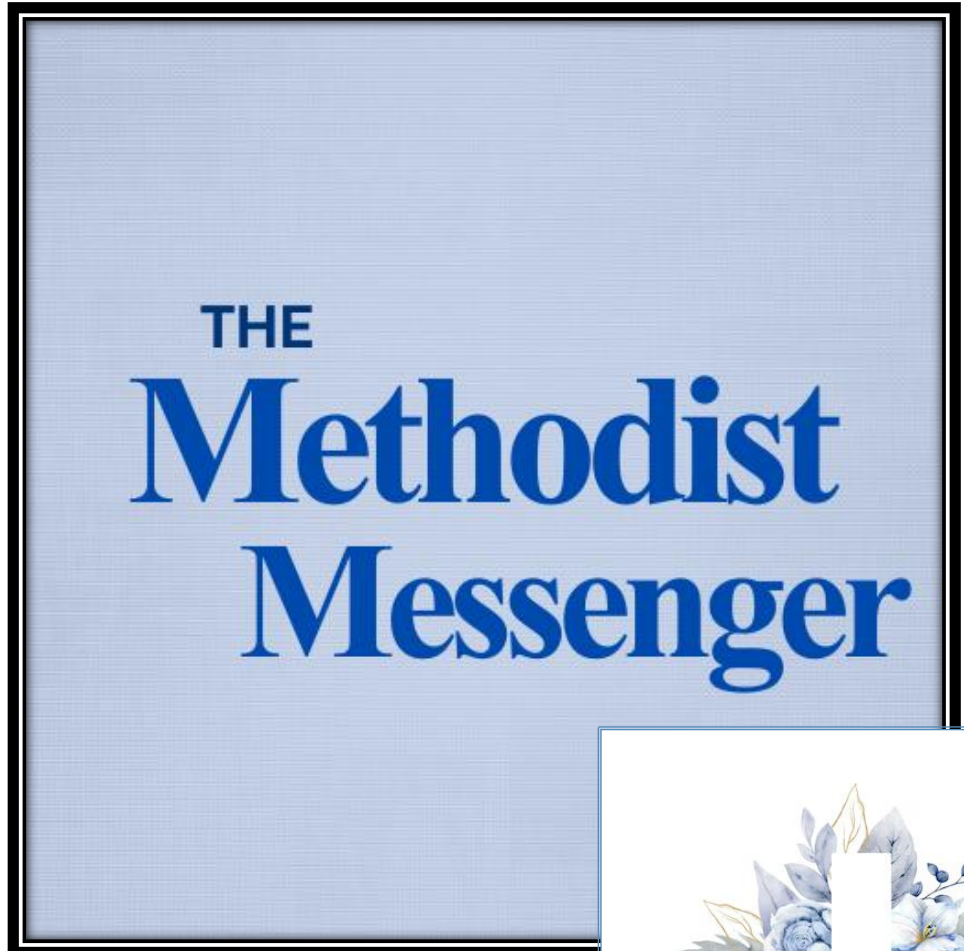

## ORGAN UPDATE

As you may be aware, our sanctuary choir loft area had an unwelcome nocturnal visitor in the early spring. A raccoon(s) has done significant damage to the organ pipes by chewing, bending and gnawing, making approximately 25 of the smaller metal ones unusable. Pipe Organ Services from Charlotte has been to look briefly and advised that these pipes will need to be removed and sent to an organ pipe builder to be repaired or replaced. We have taken photos of the damaged area including the paw prints on the walls! Our trustees will file an insurance claim when we receive an estimate of the cost. This process is likely to take a long while and be very expensive. Luckily our organ is also electronic, and the pipes can be disengaged, therefore making it useable, but not operating at its optimum capacity. Let's continue reaching out to grow our great church but exclude wildlife.

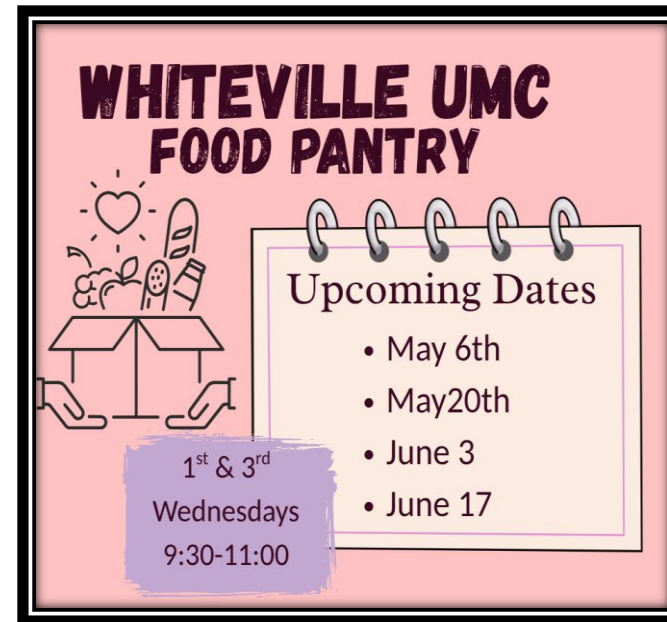
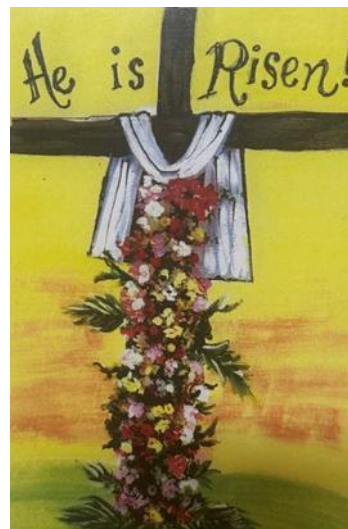


## NOW COMMITTEE
